## **Consultation on guidelines**

The Board has released a public consultation paper on the review of:

- Continuing professional development for endorsed and non-endorsed optometrists, and
- Prescription of optical appliances.

We encourage all interested practitioners, members of the community and other stakeholders to have input. Consultation will close 20 November 2015.

# Online renewal of registration is now open

Online renewal of registration is now open for optometrists registered in Australia. Optometrists can renew their general or non-practising registration on the Board's <u>website</u> by 30 November.

A series of reminders with a link to online renewal will be sent to practitioners by the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) on behalf of the Board. Optometrists must ensure that AHPRA has their current contact information so they don't miss email and letter reminders to renew.

In early September the Board announced a <u>reduction in the registration fee</u> for the registration period from 1 December 2015 to 30 November 2016.
